## Overview

How to install a ups power supply?

The most important aspect of installing a UPS power supply is connecting the batteries. The key to connecting the batteries is to link the positive terminal to the negative terminal, connecting each battery in series, and then leading out two power cables, one positive and one negative, to connect to the air switch. Can a parallel redundant system use a separate battery cabinet?

The two UPS modules may share the same battery cabinet(s), or each module may use a separate battery cabinet(s). Figure 7 shows a diagram of the parallel redundant system with UPS modules utilizing separate battery cabinets.
