How do you calculate wattage of a solar panel?

The correct calculation for wattage is: Volts x Amps = Wattage For example, $30v \times 4a = 120w$. Solar panel are more complex because the short circuit amps are what is actually being measured. Measure the amps then multiply that by the panel voltage (not the actual open circuit).

How to test a solar panel?

2. Check Open-Circuit Voltage (Voc) The open-circuit voltage (Voc) gives you an idea of the voltage output of your solar panel without a connected load.
